

One-Han Yaku: Īhan yaku

Īpēkō	Two identical shuntsu of the same suit
Menzen tsumo	Tsumo with a fully concealed hand
Pinfu	Four shuntsu and a valueless pair, out must be declared on a ryanmen (two-sided) wait
Rīchi	Tenpai hand declared at 1000 points stake
Daburī	Declaring Rīchi with the first discard of the hand
Ippatsu	Going out in the first round of discards, or the next draw, after declaring Rīchi
Chankan	Ron on the tile used to extend a kōtsu to a kantsu
Haitei	Tsumo on the last tile from the wall
Hōtei	Ron on the last discard of the hand
Rinshan kaihō	Tsumo on the tile drawn from the dead wall after declaring a kantsu
Tanyao	No terminals or honors
Yakuhai	A kōtsu or kantsu of dragons, seat wind or prevalent wind

Two-Han Yaku: Ryanhan yaku

Chī-toitsu	Seven pairs, no two being identical
– Chanta	All sets, with at least one shuntsu, contain terminals and honors
– Ikkitsūkan	The three shuntsu, 123, 456 and 789 in the same suit
– San shoku dōjun	The same shuntsu in each suit
Hon rōtō	All sets consist of terminals and honors only
San ankō	Three concealed kōtsu or kantsu
San kantsu	Three kantsu
San shoku dōkō	The same kōtsu or kantsu in each suit
Shō san gen	Two kōtsu or kantsu of dragons and a pair of the third dragon
Toi-toi hō	Four kōtsu or kantsu

Three-Han Yaku: Sanhan yaku

Ryanpēkō	Two times two identical shuntsu
– Honitsu	One suit only, plus honor tiles
– Junchan taiyao	All sets, with at least one shuntsu, contain terminals

Six-Han Yaku: Ryūhan yaku

– Chinitsu	One suit only, no honors
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Thirteen-Han Yaku: Yakuman

Chīhō	Tsumo with the first draw of the hand
Chūren pōtō	1112345678999 of a single suit and one duplicate of the same suit
Kokushi musō	One of each honor and terminal and one duplicate
Renhō	Ron in the first round of a hand
Sū ankō	Four concealed kōtsu or kantsu and a pair
Tenhō	Oya wins with initial fourteen tiles
Chinrōtō	A hand consisting of only terminals
Dai sharin	A hand of seven sequential pairs from 2 to 8 pinzu
Dai san gen	One kōtsu or kantsu of each dragon
Pārenchan	The oya completes his 9 th hand in a row, this hand requires no other yaku
Ryū īsō	A hand consisting of only 2, 3, 4, 6 and 8 sōzu and hatsu
Shō/dai sūshī	Three kōtsu or kantsu of winds and a pair of the fourth, or a kōtsu or kantsu of each wind
Sū kantsu	Four kantsu
Tsū īsō	A hand consisting of only honors

Special

Nagashi mangan	In case of an exhaustive draw, if a player has only discarded honors and terminals, none of which have been claimed, that player receives a Mangan payment from his opponents
